



**Title:** Kinetic Wind Sculpture

**Location:** Maxey Park, 30<sup>th</sup> Street and Nashville Avenue, Lubbock, TX.

**Description:** Seven mobile sculptures standing approximately 20' high in the playa lake at Maxey Park. Each piece has three separate "windmill" like components colorfully painted. These pieces move individually in the wind, which is abundant in Lubbock.

**History:** Bruce Taylor received a 1998 Grant to Artists and Organizations through the Colorado Council on the Arts. He was selected to participate in the 1998 Open Studio Program and

receive a 1998 matching grant from the Western States Arts Federation. In 1997 he was the first recipient of the Anderson Ranch Art Center visiting artist project in Snowmass, CO. During 1996 a CoVisions grant through the Colorado Council was awarded to him. The kinetic wind installation relates to the elements of wind, sun, water, and earth and how they play an important role in the community. The overall shape of the piece is in the form of a two dimensional layout of a cotton molecule, actually cellulose, cotton is over 99% cellulose. The predominate industry in the Lubbock region is cotton.

He has also had works installed in Dallas, Texas, Richmond, California, the southeastern Utah desert and several permanent and temporary pieces in Colorado.
