Description: Four female bronze figures dressed in dancer like sheaths are seated within a rock “garden” surrounded by plants and small trees. One woman reaches both hands to the sky, another sits with a palm up, and the third sits with a folded knee gazing down and the fourth reaches upward on her toes with one hand stretched out.

History: Glenna Goodacre has been a practicing artist for over forty years, however she did not begin to sculpt until she was thirty years old. Her public sculptures in America can be viewed in more than 25 states. An academician of the National Academy of Design since 1994 and a fellow of the National Sculpture Society since 1981, Goodacre has won many awards at their

exhibitions in New York. Goodacre has received honorary doctorates from Colorado College, her alma mater, and Texas Tech University in her hometown of Lubbock, Texas. In 2002 her sculpture Crossing The Prairie won the James Earl Fraser Sculpture Award at the Prix De West Exhibition in Okalahoma City. In 2003, she was awarded the prestigious Texas Medal of Arts and was inducted into the Cowgirl Hall of Fame in Forth Worth.
