

The 31st Annual Lubbock Arts Festival will be held April 30 - May 3, 2009 at the Lubbock Memorial Civic Center.

The Lubbock Arts Festival is better than ever!

The Festival is a multi-arts, multi-event celebration including the Visual Arts, Performing Arts, and Children's Arts. In addition to fine arts and crafts, festival goers will enjoy live musical performances, culinary arts, and children's activities. Individual artists are being invited to purchase booths to provide visitors and collectors a diverse offering of fine art.

The Lubbock Arts Festival is produced by the Lubbock Arts Alliance, Inc., a not-for-profit arts agency dedicated to fostering the creation, enjoyment and understanding of the arts. Proceeds from the Festival provide funding for year-round educational and community programs.

Creating a welcoming and enjoyable atmosphere for visiting artists is one of our specialties. The Lubbock Arts Festival features a private artists' hospitality area and volunteer booth sitters as well as other amenities.

General Entry Information

All artwork must be the original, handmade work of the artist and produced within 18 months of the 2009 Festival. Reproduced prints may not constitute more than 50% of the displayed work. Media using endangered animals or plants and t-shirts are specifically excluded. Works produced from other sources

and commercial patterns or kits are ineligible. All resale items are ineligible for this show.

An on-site standards committee will be present to enforce eligibility policies.

Artists who are found in violation of these restrictions will be required to remove those items from their booths. The Lubbock Arts Festival reserves the right to close the booth of any artist who refuses to adhere to the regulations set forth in this prospectus.

The Lubbock Arts Festival is juried for a general audience and reserves the right to remove any work deemed unsuitable by Festival officials.

Booth Information

A 10' x 10' or 10' x 20' booth space made of pipe and drape or pegboard is available for artists featuring work in the fine arts and fine crafts. Booths have a flat fee — no commission on sales will be charged.

- Single Booth - Pipe & Drape: \$300 (10'x10')
- Single Corner Booth (as available) - Pipe & Drape: \$350 (10'x10')
- Single Booth - Pegboard: \$350 (10'x10')
- Double Booth - Pipe & Drape: \$400 (10'x 20')
- Double Corner Booth (as available) - Pipe & Drape: \$450 (10'x 20')
- Double Booth - Pegboard: \$450 (10'x 20')

Artists may bring their own booth set-ups, but no tents. One (1) unskirted table, two (2) folding chairs, and five hundred (500) watts of electricity are provided FREE to each booth. Additional tables are available for a \$10 rental fee. Booth fees are non-refundable if applicant is juried in. Spaces are preassigned and all assignments are final.

Artist Amenities

Artist amenities include volunteer booth sitters, access to a private hospitality area stocked with refreshments, and lunch is provided on Friday and Saturday.

Admission

All adult festival goers will be admitted for \$1.00 and all children age 12 and under, accompanied by an adult, will be admitted for free.
